



S.A.D.B.C CAMP POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Mission & Purpose: The S.A.D.B.C. is composed of three components: Academic Advisement, Life Skills and Instructional Basketball Lessons. Our mission is to provide proper guidance through educational and recreational outreach in the community. Merritting Attention gives people of all ages the space and direction needed to help them develop into positive and mature individuals. We believe that in concert with academic pursuits, athletics can challenge students to develop useful life skills. Athletics give students the opportunity to apply life-long values and habits. The core focus of the program is to “establish merit through academic and athletic achievements.”

What to bring to Camp

Please send your child to camp prepared every Saturday. He/she will need to wear their Merritting Attention camp t-shirt and shorts which is provided. All students are expected to bring homework, a reading book and their completed weekly progress report which will be given to them at camp every Saturday. Please do not send your child with money, candy, gum, or basketballs. Merritting Attention is not responsible for any loss or stolen personal property.

Academic Enrichment

The students should come prepared with schoolwork. We promote academic excellence and literacy across the curriculum. We will be giving progress reports to the parents on a weekly basis, to be submitted to the teachers for completion, in order for us to monitor how well the students are doing in school. It is crucial that students bring work from home or school. There will be an academic room for those students who need to study as well as do their homework. Occasionally, we will have guest speakers during the camp session to speak to the students about various topics.

Fundamentals of Basketball

All participants will learn the proper techniques on how to dribble, pass, shoot and play defense. Guest speakers will consist of high school and college basketball coaches or players. They will demonstrate a variety of drills and plays as well as talk about the “**Game of Life**” (How to be successful on and off the court).

Arrival/Departure/Absences/Tardiness/Late Fees

S.A.D.B.C. starts promptly at 10:00AM and ends at 12:00PM. All parents must sign their child in and out for safety reasons and to verify attendance. **Late Arrivals** will not be tolerated. Students who arrive after 10:30AM may not be admitted into camp for that day. **Late pick up will result in a \$1.00 per minute late fee, which must be paid before returning to camp.** Students are allowed two unexcused absences at which time they may be terminated from the camp session.

Discipline Policy

S.A.D.B.C. does not tolerate profanity, violent or inappropriate behavior, teasing or bullying. Again, we work to ensure a safe & fun environment for participants and staff. There are no refunds for children suspended due to disciplinary actions.

Medication

Written permission for any medication used or administered during camp hours must be given to the Program Director or his designee before the start of camp. All medications must be in its original container and marked with the child’s name. Please notify us of any medical conditions we should be aware of at the time of registration.

Transportation

Transportation is available on a first come-first serve basis at an additional fee. Please see Camp Director Larry Merritt for more information.
